

Wragg Castle Lane Junction on A4173

Traffic at this section of the A4173 travels at speed creating hazards for traffic turning into and out of Wragg Castle Lane due to limited visibility with the additional hazard of a double bend in the road. Three to four vehicles per year have left the road crashing into the field on the Stroud side of the bend and resulting in the need to call out the Emergency Services.



Footpath from Rudge Hill opposite Edgemoor Inn leading down to the Cotswold Way



This footpath is utilised by walkers on a regular basis to join the Cotswold Way in Jenkins Lane or stopping off at the Edgemoor Inn prior to joining the Cotswold Way walk. As you can see above, vehicles travelling towards Gloucester on the A4173 are obscured from walkers vision.

Kingsmill Junction on A46 near Painswick

This junction is close to the 50mph speed limit from exiting Painswick's 30mph speed limit. This junction is regularly used by Painswick residents to join the A46 and as shown below visibility is close to zero.
